- -Pandemic It was a fun new activity where participants were given a word/phrase and got to expand it and create their own little Pandemic with a micro fiction tale of less than 60 words. The participants were awarded points in these events, which were conducted on WhatsApp, which were compiled throughout the week and the winners were announced on the Biblichor Instagram page (07/04/2020- 12/04/2020)
